65% turnout sets stage...

Stakes are high for both the ruling NDA and the opposition INDIA bloc, with several key leaders, including RJD's Yadav, Deputy CMs Samrat Choudhary and Vijay Kumar Sinha, besides a slew of ministers, being among the 1,314 candidates in fray in this phase. Stray incidents of violence, including an alleged attack on Sinha's vehicle, were reported from some areas during the polling. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who has addressed rallies in a couple of constituencies going to polls in the second and final phase, felt that the noticeably high number of women turning up to vote was a good sign for the NDA. "Mothers, daughters, and sisters have been the worst sufferers of 'jungle raj'. Today, they seem to have put up a fortress around polling booths to prevent the return of 'jungle raj'," Modi remarked.

PM: RJD, Cong have...

Only the NDA can ensure that this journey towards growth continues uninterrupted," he added. Modi said the NDA faces a big challenge on this journey of growth, which is the menace of infiltration. "The NDA is committed to driving out each and every infiltrator from the country. But the Congress-RJD offer them protection, take out political yatras in their favour and come up with misleading narratives," alleged the PM in an indirect reference to Leader of the Opposition Rahul Gandhi's "Voter Adhikar Yatra" and allegations of "vote theft". "Whenever the RJD-Congress achieve power, they try to give back-door entry to infiltrators. They do so because of vote bank politics. But this takes a toll on the people of this country. The infiltrators claim a share in all that belongs to the citizens," he added.

Modi plays down...

While the conversation was expected to focus on cricket and the team's remarkable achievement, Harleen Deol's candid question about PM Modi's skincare routine brought an unexpected twist. Everyone in the room, including the PM, burst into laughter after hearing the question. Smiling, PM Modi responded, "Mera iss vishay par zyada dhyaan nahi gya tha (I have never paid attention to this)."

Talks with Modi going...

When asked directly if he planned to travel to India next year, Trump replied, "It could be, yes." This comes months after The New York Times, in its August report, had said that US President Donald Trump no longer intends to visit India for the upcoming Quad Summit later this year, following Washington's decision to impose heavy tariffs.

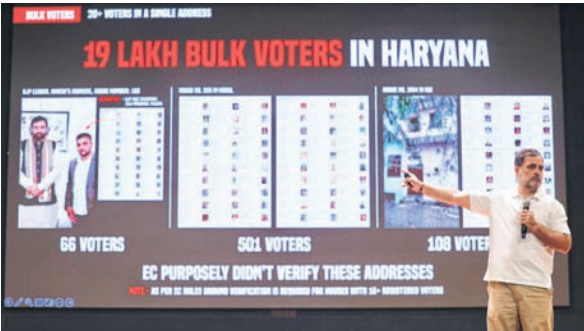
POLL OUTCRY | Party to submit memorandum to Murmu on Nov 8

Cong's 5 cr 'Vote Chori' signatures to reach Prez

The Congress on Thursday renewed its allegation of electoral manipulation and "Vote Chori", outlining its plan to submit a memorandum with over 5 crore signatures to President Droupadi Murmu on November 8 for seeking urgent corrective action. K. C. Venugopal, General Secretary, AICC, (Organisation), in a statement, said that so far over 5 crore signatures have been collected nationwide - a powerful testimony to the anger, apprehension, and deep concern among citizens about the "naked murder of democracy through manipulative practices such as duplicate voting, fake voter entries, and fraudulent addresses in the electoral rolls". 'Movement to defend democracy' As part of Congress party's nationwide movement to defend democracy, the party launched the "Vote Chor Gaddi Chod" Signature Campaign, a mass public outreach and door-to-door initiative to mobilise citizens against electoral fraud, Venugopal said.

"Vote Chor Gaddi Chod" campaign, Venugopal said through the signature campaign the public has made five clear and

democratic demands from the Election Commission of India: Prosecute officials and agents involved in systematic voter

suppression; publish a machine-readable voter list with photographs for public scrutiny; release all deletion and addition lists with photographs before every election; establish a grievance redressal mechanism for wrongful deletions and announce a clear cut-off date for voter list changes, avoiding last-minute manipulations. The Congress General Secretary said the party has been consistently raising concerns about electoral roll manipulation and large-scale electoral fraud undermining the sanctity of the democratic process. Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi has repeatedly exposed the dangerous "vote chori" orchestrated by the BJP in collusion with the Election Commission of India, a direct assault on the people's mandate, he said.

The Left Unity on Thursday retained its stronghold in the Jawaharlal Nehru University here, effecting a clean sweep to win all four central panel posts in the students' union elections. The alliance of the All India Students' Association (AISA), Students' Federation of India

(SFI) and Democratic Students' Federation (DSF) swept the polls, reaffirming its dominance on the campus. Aditi Mishra was elected president after defeating RSS-backed ABVP's Vikas Patel by 449 votes. Kizhakoot Gopika Babu bagged the vice-president's post after trouncing Tanya Kumari, while Sunil Yadav and Danish Ali won the posts of general secretary and joint secretary after defeating their right-wing rivals Rajeshwar Kant Dubey and Anuj, respectively.
