Man tonsured, paraded over phone theft charge

Three people, including a father-son duo, were detained after a video purportedly showing a man being tonsured, made to wear a shoe garland and paraded here surfaced on the internet, police said on Monday. The incident took place in Pathakpur village under the Asiwani police station area, they said.

According to police, Sonu, 30, a resident of the village, was accused of stealing a mobile phone on the night of July 30, when Raju and his son Raj were sleeping outside their hut in an orchard outside the village.

The police said the phone was later found near a locked kiosk. Following this, the father-son duo and Anil caught Sonu and took him to his house to complain about the alleged theft. Onu was later tied with a rope, his head was shaved and half of his moustache was cut.

COURT CORNER| Supreme Court seeks response on plea for tougher drug law enforcement

Top court notice on plea for time-bound NDPS probes

The Supreme Court on Monday issued notices to the Centre and state governments on a public interest litigation (PIL) seeking comprehensive reforms under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act to tackle the growing drug menace and dismantle organised drug trafficking networks across the country.

A bench of Chief Justice of India Surya Kant and Justices Joymalya Bagchi and V Mohana said it was a "very serious matter". The problem is nationwide, and there is a need for better coordination among the agencies, observed the bench.

Justice Bagchi high-



lighted the cross-border trafficking of narcotic drugs, particularly from the Golden Crescent region of Asia. "All these things are very relevant. With the international border as India has, you see the Golden Crescent, you see in Burma and in Afghanistan," said Justice Bagchi.

The plea filed by advocate Ashwini Upadhyay sought a slew of directions to strengthen the fight against drug trafficking, including time-bound investigation

and trial of narcotics cases, confiscation of properties of traffickers and creation of a uniform investigation protocol across the country.

The petition sought directions to the Centre, States and the Law Commission to strengthen investigation, prosecution and rehabilitation mechanisms under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act.

The petition urged the apex court to direct the Centre and State governments to prescribe mandatory timelines for submission of Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) reports in all NDPS cases and frame Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for search, seizure and sampling. It also sought constitution of Special Courts under

Sections 36 and 36A of the NDPS Act to ensure time-bound investigation and speedy trial.

Among its key prayers, the PIL sought directions to establish an expert committee for identification and timely scheduling of New Psychoactive Substances (NPS), implement mandatory digital recording and videography of search, seizure and sampling proceedings, and create rehabilitation and wellness centres under Sections 39 and 64A of the NDPS Act for treatment of addicts. The petitioner further sought a graded sentencing policy prescribing stricter punishment for traffickers, financiers and organised drug syndicates while treating addicts and personal-use offenders differently.

39 arrested, drugs worth Rs 55.80 cr seized

Around 39 persons, eight of them foreigners, were arrested and narcotic substances worth an estimated Rs 55.80 crore were seized from their possession, police said on Monday.

The action was taken as part of the 'BEDA BRO' programme, an initiative under Mission RISE and the Bengaluru City Police's anti-drug campaign, they said.

Speaking to reporters, Bengaluru City Police Commissioner Seemant Kumar Singh said drugs worth more than Rs 55 crore had been seized from various locations in Bengaluru and other states—Delhi, Noida, Gurugram and Kerala as part of Mission RISE.

BJP warns Muslim League over Savarkar row

The BJP on Monday warned the Muslim League against "provoking" the party over the controversy surrounding the suspension of a teacher for a question on V D Savarkar.

The party took a swipe at the Congress over the Vande Mataram row, said, "If that is the case, let them sing the Italian national anthem." BJP state president Rajeev Chandrasekhar said the party would not remain silent if the Muslim League, a prominent Congress ally in Kerala whose minister holds the General Education

portfolio, tried to "bring back" what he described as an old practice of creating a particular narrative.

"Don't provoke us," he said, adding that the Muslim League should not interfere in matters concerning Savarkar, whom he described as "an important part of India's freedom struggle".

Hitting out at the Congress over its government's decision that the full version of Vande Mataram would not be sung in the state, the BJP leader said the national anthem and national song of this country were not decided from the time when the government led by the grand old party was in power.

Man hacked to death over relationship with woman from another community

A 28-year-old man was allegedly hacked to death with a spade over a long-standing relationship with a woman belonging to another community in Uttar Pradesh's Maharajganj district, police said on Monday.

The incident took place on Sunday night in Kharkhora village under the Brijmanganj police station area.

According to the police, the deceased, identified as Hazari,

was engaged in fish farming and lived in the village.

Villagers said Hazari had allegedly been involved in a long-standing relationship with a woman belonging to another community, which had led to tensions between the two families in the past.

On Sunday evening, some relatives of the woman reportedly visited Hazari's house, during which an argument broke out between the two sides and soon escalated into a physical altercation.

Hyd police warn women of rent boyfriend dating scam

Hyderabad: Hyderabad Police Commissioner V.C. Sajjana, IPS, has issued a public warning about a new cyber fraud targeting women and young girls through social media under the guise of "Rent Boyfriend" offers.

VC Sajjanar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, talking to his X handle, wrote, "Feeling lonely? Want a

handsome guy to have coffee with you, go to the movies with you? And that too with 50% OFF! Behind these colourful posters circulating on social media in the name of various offers lies a big cyber fraud. This is a new dating trap being set by cyber fraudsters, specifically targeting girls and young women." ANI
